

**SPENCER BROOK TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
MONDAY April 13th, 2026**

IN ATTENDANCE: Chairperson Brad Brown, Supervisor Gerald Frascone, Supervisor Arvid Jenkins, Treasurer Audrey Misiura, Clerk Jennifer Jenkins, Deputy Clerk Myla Tolmie

CALL TO ORDER: 7:00pm

RESIDENTS: 4

RESIDENT INPUT: Kay Fenning brought up about people dumping garbage in the ditches on Tiger St; people not paying attention to the speed limit signs on Tiger St. and wondering if there was some way the township could make the signs more visible; a neighbor's house was shot at.

Dennis Kowalik stated that he has been in contact with the people for the fence around the Veteran's Tribute area. He stated that he will be getting a quote for labor/materials and will return to Township Board for approval when received.

Bill Tessmer; Bogart and Pederson engineering service, gives a presentation on 303rd and 305th on what the township can do to repair the road within Spencer Brook Townships budget.

B. Gracie Plat Discussion: Simple Lot Split. Does not need to go to the Planning Commission. Motion made by Supervisor Arvid Jenkins and seconded by Supervisor Gerald Frascone to approve the simple lot split. All in favor, motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. Gravel Bids: Discussion commenced about revising the gravel bid, or not getting gravel this year. Item tabled until next month.

B. Spring Clean Up Day: Motion was made by supervisor Arvid Jenkins and seconded by Supervisor Gerald Frascone to have the spring clean up day on Saturday, May 2nd from 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. at the township garage and that advertising will be done as an ad in Scotsman and Town and country and on the website. All in favor motion carried. Supervisor Arvid Jenkins made a motion to have Evergreen, Lepage, and Barthold's as vendors for clean-up day, which was 2nded by Supervisor Gerald Frascone. All in favor, motion carried.

PLANNING COMMISSION:

FIRE BOARD UPDATE:

A. Princeton Fire Report: Supervisor Gerald Frascone reported that the next meeting will be on May 6th.

B. Isanti Joint Fire: Supervisor Arvid Jenkins reports 31 total runs for the district, no calls in Spencer Brook Township. 2026 new hires are doing training. The next meeting is at Station 1.

ROAD AND BRIDGE:

Supervisors Arvid Jenkins and Gerald Frascone will be doing road inspection on Sunday, April 19th and bring reports to the monthly meeting in May. Chait Brad Brown has been doing 911 signs, and received a post delivery from M and R signs. Both Brad Brown and Audrey had attended the ditch meeting which had no conclusions.

CLERK REPORT: Deputy Clerk Myla Tomie gave a report on the Mat training she and Treasurer Audrey Misiura attended. The report included having a consent agenda, having utility payments on auto pay and having an amazon business account. The supervisor discussed and conclude having the utility payments set on the budget pay might help, no other conclusions were made. Clerk Jennifer Jenkins spoke about an email asking for public record request, which the supervisor's feel is a scam. Clerk Jennifer Jenkins concluded informing the residents about Princeton school referendum.
