CALL TO ORDER: 7:00pm

AGENDA: Supervisor Arvid Jenkins made a motion, seconded by Supervisor Gerald Frascone to approve the agenda. All in favor, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion was made by Supervisor Arvid Jenkins to approve the minutes of the May meeting minutes with corrections, Seconded by Supervisor Gerald Frascone, all in favor. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: None.

NEW BUSINESS: 303rd and 305th Curve sign. Clerk Jennifer Jenkins speaks for resident Janelle Meade in her request for a curve sign because many residents walk with kids and pets. The Board of Supervisors agreed. Supervisor Arvid Jenkins makes a motion to place a curve sign with the plan road and improvements on 303rd and 305th. Supervisor Gerald Frascone 2nds. All in favor, motion carried.

PLANNING COMMISSION: None.

FIRE BOARD UPDATE: The Princeton Fire meeting is July 1st, which Supervisor Gerald Frascione reports.

Supervisor Arvid Jenkins reports Isanti Fire District reported 41 runs for the month of May, 2026; 0 were for Spencer Brook. They are accepting new applicants, they were turned down for a grant for the ladder truck, but applied for a grant on the new tender. They are looking for repairs on Station 1, peak in the roof is leaking. Station 2 has issues with mold. Athens Township rep resigned. For the run report they have a 6 minutes response time, 5 were fires, 9 were auto, 13 medical, /false alarm. Next meeting is June 17 at station 3.

ROAD AND BRIDGE: William Tessmer for Bogart and Pederson reports the bids for 303rd and 305th road work. Supervisor Arvid Jenkins makes a motion to accept the Hanson 303rd/305th bid which was the lowest and have a completion date for September 1st, 2026. Supervisor Gerald Frascione 2nds the motion. All in favor, motion carried. Supervisor Arvid picked up tires along the roadside. Chair Brad Brown did the driveway permits and 911 signs for Mike Kelzenberg's plat. Dirt works will repair the Blue Lake North access.

CLERK REPORT: Clerk Jennifer Jenkins speaks working on Clean up day report. Clerk Jennifer Jenkins talks about the schoolhouse and she had not heard back from the Boettcher's. Ken Shore also wanted the swing outside of the schoolhouse. The Supervisors agreed Ken can have the swing. The Supervisor asked Clerk Jennifer Jenkins to call the Boettcher's once more to see if they are still interested, or should the Township will plan to advertise sale in the fall. Dennis Kowalik and Deputy Clerk Myla Tolmie give an update to the Veteran's tribute.

TREASURER REPORT: Clerk Jennifer Jenkins reads Treasurer Audrey Misiura report, along with claims, balances, Gopher Bounty. Supervisor Arvid Jenkins makes a motion to approve the claims and accept the Treasurer's report, which Supervisor Gerald Frascone 2nds. All in favor, motion carried.
